



**DECEMBER 2015 NEWSLETTER -- PLEASE KEEP FOR REFERENCE**

**RECYCLING:** The Town has contracted with Advanced Disposal to provide a recycling cart for all residential units. Place all acceptable recyclable items in the cart, and then set the cart at the end of your driveway by 7:00 a.m. on your recycling pickup day. Recyclables will be **picked up every other Thursday according your week.** The updated **recycling schedule and guidelines are listed on the back,** please review them and keep for your reference. **Landlords,** it is your responsibility to give your renters a copy of this information.

**Note:** It is illegal to put consumer electronics such as TVs, computers, printers, etc. in the trash. For information on where to recycle these items go to <http://dnr.wi.gov/topic/Ecycle>.

**GARBAGE PICKUP:** You will need to contract with a private hauler for your own garbage pickup. **BRUSH** – can be dropped off on the east side of the parking lot at the Town Hall.

**BUILDING / ZONING PERMITS:** Contact Building Inspector & Zoning Administrator, John Derler, at 262-692-2039, to find out if your project requires a permit, and for all other building and zoning needs.

**DRIVEWAY REGULATIONS:** *A permit is required for new driveway or culvert installation-* Contact Supervisor Mark Foye at 262-692-3038 for information **before** doing any work.

**DOGS:** Except for puppies under six months of age, no more than three (3) dogs allowed unless you have a multiple dog license, which requires a conditional use permit. Contact Treasurer, Ken Ramthun, at 262-338-8442 for dog licensing.

**ELECTIONS:** Refer to the “Election Information” link on our website, or go to the Government Accountability Board’s website at [gab.wi.gov](http://gab.wi.gov) for election information and voter forms. For additional election questions, contact the Clerk.

**SNOW PLOWING:** When clearing snow out of your yard, do not push it across the road. Plow the snow into a place in *your* yard. If you must plow snow across the road, be sure it is off of the road right-of-way and completely pushed onto *your* own property. It is imperative that you clear the road of any snow that you pushed across the road.

**JUNKED / UNLICENSED VEHICLES:** The Town ordinance prohibits unlicensed vehicles in the yard unless you have a parcel in excess of 40 acres – then 3 would be allowed. This ordinance will be enforced – any person violating this ordinance may be fined \$50 - \$500, together with the costs of prosecution, or imprisoned in the county jail until such fines are paid, not to exceed 30 days.

**A WEEK** is for homes located on STH 144, west of STH 144 and north of CTH H

**B WEEK** is for homes located on CTH H, south of CTH H, and east of STH 144

*Please place the following in recycle cart, DO NOT BAG:*

**MIXED CONTAINERS**

- Aluminum cans & clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans, steel cans, aerosol cans, empty/dried paint cans
- Glass bottles & Jars
- Plastic #1-7
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

**MIXED PAPER**

- Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard
- Gray chipboard (cereal & shoe boxes)
- Brown paper bags
- Shredded paper (bagged in clear plastic, only bagged exception)

**DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING IN THE RECYCLE CART**

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Trash
- Construction Materials
- Clothing
- Yard waste
- Household hazardous waste
- Electronics
