



Recycling Guidelines

Place ALL of the following in recycling cart. DO NOT BAG, except for shredded paper. Place cart at the end of your driveway by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled recycling pick-up date. Landlords, it is your responsibility to inform your renters of these guidelines.

MIXED CONTAINERS:

- ◆ Aluminum cans & clean aluminum foil
- ◆ Tin cans, steel cans, aerosol cans, empty/dried paint cans
- ◆ Glass bottles & jars
- ◆ Plastic #1-7
- ◆ Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

MIXED PAPER:

- ◆ Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/office paper
- ◆ Brown corrugated cardboard
- ◆ Gray chipboard (cereal & shoe boxes)
- ◆ Brown paper bags
- ◆ Shredded paper (*bagged in clear plastic, only bagged exception*)

DO NOT PUT IN CART:

- ◆ Styrofoam of any kind
- ◆ Trash
- ◆ Construction Materials
- ◆ Clothing
- ◆ Yard waste
- ◆ Household hazardous waste
- ◆ Electronics

Garbage Pick-up & Brush



You need to contract with a private hauler for you own garbage pick-up needs. Local haulers include Advanced Disposal and Waste Management. Brush can be dropped off on the east side of the parking lot at the Town Hall.
