**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE WISCONSIN 9/11 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY**

**WHEREAS**, on the morning of September 11, 2001, the deadliest attack on American soil occurred when four passenger airlines were hijacked by terrorists and crashed into a field in Shanksville, Pennsylvania, the Pentagon in Washington D.C., and the towers of the World Trade Center in New York City; and

**WHEREAS**, the attack took the lives of 2,977 people including Kewaskum High School graduate Andrea Lyn Haberman who was present in the north tower when it was struck by American Airlines Flight 11 at approximately 8:46 a.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, after many applications and years of waiting, a piece of steel section from an I-beam, which was located on a lower floor of the north tower, arrived in Kewaskum for display in 2014; and


**WHEREAS**, the volunteers of Kewaskum Remembers 9/11, Inc., a 501(c)(3) organization, have broken ground on the Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial in the village of Kewaskum to remember all those who lost their lives, to honor all who have served our country in the ensuing conflicts, to thank all first responders, to recognize the volunteers who worked at Ground Zero to recover remains, and are now succumbing to various cancers and diseases, and to showcase the strength, resilience, and compassion of America and its people;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town of Farmington Town Board that we support Senator Duey Stroebel and Representative Timothy Ramthun's efforts to designate and mark the route of STH 28, commencing at the I 41 and STH 28 interchange in Dodge County and proceeding easterly to the intersection with STH 144 in Washington County, as the "Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial Highway."

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town of Farmington Town Clerk send a copy of this resolution to the Office of the Governor, Senator Duey Stroebel, Representative Timothy Ramthun and the Washington County Clerk.
