

**Ordinance No. 2019-05
State of Wisconsin

Town of Farmington**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMIT ON BOLTON DRIVE AND PINE LANE IN
THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS, the Town of Farmington and Washington County entered into a jurisdictional transfer agreement transferring two portions of County Highway DD from the Washington County Highway System to the Town of Farmington, and

WHEREAS, the jurisdictional transfer was approved by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and the transfer will be effective October 31, 2019, and

WHEREAS, upon the effective date of the removal it will be necessary to establish speed limit for the transferred portions of roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., and general authority under its village powers under s. 60.22, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

SECTION II – SPEED LIMIT BOLTON DRIVE

A speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Bolton Drive in the Town of Farmington between and STH 144 and Scenic Drive, and a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Bolton Drive in the Town of Farmington between Scenic Drive and Boltonville Road, and a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Bolton Drive in the Town of Farmington between Boltonville Road and STH 144 is hereby established.

SECTION III – SPEED LIMIT PINE LANE

A speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Pine Lane in the Town of Farmington between STH 144 and STH 144 is hereby established.

SECTION IV - SIGNAGE

Pursuant to s. 349.11(5), Wis. Stats., the Town Chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs indicating the established mile per hour speed limit on Bolton Drive and on Pine Lane.

SECTION V - VIOLATION

No person may operate any vehicle on Bolton Drive and Pine Lane in violation of the established mile per hour speed limit. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.


SECTION VII – EFFECTIVE DATE


