These 2x2 ft. four-chamber bat nursery houses are available for purchase at \$100 each (limited availability). All proceeds will go towards the Washington County Natural Resources Department - Tree & Prairie Seed Program.

Bats play a critical role in keeping insect populations in balance. Bats will eat mosquitoes, moths, beetles, flies, termites and spiders. They will also eat agricultural pests such as corn borers, cutworm moths, potato beetles and grasshoppers - they eat massive quantities of insects!
