RESOLUTION TO PETITION WASHINGTON COUNTY BRIDGE REPLACEMENT/REPAIR FUNDING FOR THE ORCHARD VALLEY CULVERT/BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

To the County Board of Washington County, Wisconsin:

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Washington County, Wisconsin, petitions the County Board of Washington County, Wisconsin, as follows:

- 1. The Town of Farmington was awarded a grant from the Department of Transportation in the amount of \$1.2 Million through the Agricultural Road Improve Program(ARIP) to reconstruct Orchard Valley Rd.
- 2. The ARIP program has a cost share of 90% State and 10% Local funding for the project.
- 3. A portion of the project includes a bridge/culvert repair/replacement located south of Shalom Dr.
- 4. The Town of Farmington has scheduled reconstruction in 2026,
- 5. The total estimated cost for the bridge/culvert portion of the project is \$24,000, which includes Engineering and Administration cost.
- 6. The Town of Farmington is petitioning the Washington County Bridge Aid Program for 50% of the repair/replacement cost.
- 7. The Town of Farmington is seeking funding assistance in the amount of \$12,000.00.

Wherefore, the Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Washington County, Wisconsin, petitions for an appropriation to be made by the county to aid the replacement of the bridge, as provided by \S 82.08, Wis. Stats.
