New Schedule for Washington County Disaster Recovery Center

WEST BEND, WI – Washington County residents and businesses impacted by the August flooding can receive in-person guidance on the application process and available resources at a joint Disaster Recovery Center. Please note the new schedule:

The center will be open Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at 333 E Washington St, West Bend in the Public Agency Center- Lower Level (parking available in the lower level lot off of Indiana Ave.)

The closing date of the center will be announced at a later date.

Online FEMA applications are still being accepted. For phone assistance with your application or with followup questions, please call the FEMA Helpline: 1-800-621-3362 (7 a.m. to 11 p.m. Eastern Time, 7 days a week).

Please note, the **deadline to apply** for FEMA Individual Assistance (damage to homes, personal losses, etc.) is **November 12, 2025**. The US Small Business Association (SBA) deadline for physical property damage is November 10, 2025, and the economic injury application deadline is June 11, 2026.
